## Supply List

- 3 stretched canvases, minimum 16 x 20 or larger if you like
- Brushes – you will be MUCH happier with a GOOD set of brushes, such as
  - o Choose bristles that are Red Sable or Kolinsky or Kevrin/Mongoose or Hog Bristle or Badger
  - o Shape/size Required (or very similar)
    - Bright /size 12 (10/32") These have a square appearance
    - Bright /size 6 (6/32")
    - Filbert /size 16 (9/16") These are rounded rectangles
    - Filbert /size 2 (3/32")
    - Flat /1 to 1.5 inch (this one may be synthetic)
    - Palette knives (1 or 2, see recommended shapes right:
  - o Shape/size Optional but nice to have
    - Angular size 8
    - Fan top spread approx 1.5 to 2 inches
- Oil Paints – oil mixable, not water.
  - o Individual tubes - required
    - Titanium White (large)\*
    - Lemon or Hansa Yellow\*
    - Pthalo blue (green shade)\*
    - Permanent rose or Quinacrodone Magenta\*
    - Black
  - o The following are nice to have in priority order – not required:
    - Cadmium red medium
    - Burnt Umber
    - Burnt Sienna
    - Yellow Ochre
    - Ultramarine Blue
    - Alizarin Crimson
    - Cadmium Orange
    - Raw Umber
    - Viridian Green
- Acrylic Paints – for underpainting (optional, but recommended)
  - Large white
  - Yellow Ochre
- Old rag and plastic bag to carry it in
- Palatte or Pad of Palette Paper (less messy)
- 1 small can of Turpenoid (this is a non-smelling turpentine available from art supply stores)
- Bottle of Liquin medium
- 2 Metal painters cups or baby food type jars with lids
- Reference photos (preferably that you have taken)
  - o Choose photos with dramatic lighting and shadow, any subject matter
- Imagination and enthusiasm – required!
