Supply List

- 2 full sheets or 6 half sheets of sanded pastel paper
Art Spectrum-Colorfix any color except white, (bring one black if you have never tried that)
Or Wallis
Preferably not Canson's Mi Tientes
- 1 sheet of sanded pastel paper cut into small pieces, approximately 4 x 6 – bring 12 pieces
- Set of soft pastels (not oil pastel) that fit your budget –
NuPastel or Rembrandt
It is good to have Sennelier or Unison if you want to invest
- Vine or willow charcoal
- Stumps or tortillon
- Small foam brush
- Old towel
- Large drawing board or foam core
- Reference photos (preferably that you have taken)
- Artist's tape
- Imagination and enthusiasm
