



## OIL PAINTING SUPPLY LIST

Some Art Supply stores offer student discounts, be sure to inquire.

Several items below are RECOMMENDED, however, if you have existing supplies or find economical sets with different brushes or colors, you may use them instead. Note: BE SURE YOU HAVE OIL PAINTS, not acrylic or watercolor -- all these come in tubes so be sure to read the label.

**Canvases:** (depends on number of classes.)

Plan on 1 canvas per 2 classes for 6 week sessions.

Plan on 1 canvas per day for workshops.

Minimum 16 x 20 or larger if you like

Canvas pad (8 x 10 or larger) for exercises and experimenting

**Brushes:** you will be MUCH happier with a GOOD set of brushes. Excellent brushes are Red Sable or Kolinsky or Kevrin/Mongoose or Hog Bristle or Badger. These are not required, but I do RECOMMEND staying away from the stiff, white synthetic brushes, they will be UNSatisfactory for you.

Recommended shape/sizes (or very similar; it is ok to get a prepackaged set, but be sure you have one brush at least 1 inch wide)

-Flat or Bright # 24 (31/32") These have a square appearance

- Flat or Bright # 16 (9/16")

-Bright /size 6 (6/32")

-Filbert /size 12 (12/32") These are rounded rectangles

-Filbert /size 2 (3/32")

-Palette knife (1) metal, not plastic

**Oil Paints :** Individual tubes in the colors below are recommended, or a prepackaged set as long as it has white, a red, a blue and a yellow. Black is not necessary.

-Titanium White (large)

-Lemon or Hansa Yellow

-Ochre

-Ultramarine blue

-Pthalo blue (green shade)- also known as Windsor blue

- Alizarin Crimson, Permanent rose or Quinacrodone Magenta

-Cadmium red

-Burnt sienna

-Sap green

### Miscellaneous

Soft rags and plastic bag to carry it in

-Palette - the Paper Pad of Palette Paper is recommended, it is far easier to clean up

-1 small can of Turpenoid (this is a non-smelling turpentine available from art supply stores)

-Small bottle of Liquin medium – (original/regular)

-2 metal painter's cups or baby food type jars with lids

-Reference photos (preferably that you have taken). Choose photos with dramatic lighting and shadow, any subject matter

-Imagination and enthusiasm are required!
