- * Class Description: Oil over acrylic - use acrylic underpainting to eliminate long drying times and produce vibrant floral paintings with fresh, rich brush strokes or palette knife strokes. Create pleasing compositions using healthier water-mixable acrylics and oils. For beginner to advanced students.
- * Supplies:
 - One or two 14 by 11 canvases (Hobby Lobby has two packs 40% off coupon you can get the coupon online)
 - Three quarter Bright brush (Hobby Lobby 50% off)
 - Half inch Bright brush same
 - Filbert brush medium size
 - Round brush very small
 - Palette knife small
 - Small acrylic set golden or similar (Michaels has coupons)
 - Small Aqua Duo Holbein water mixable oils available online or Winsor Newton water mixable oils. Water mixable is healthier. (Hobby Lobby coupon or Hobby Lobby online).
 - Butcher's tray or mixing palette or foam plates (foam better than paper plates)

- Paper towels
- Water cup or jar plastic
- Pencil H B or similar
- White colored pencil
- Water mixable linseed oil
- Inexpensive T-Square and Triangle or borrow mine.
