Charles Heinrich:

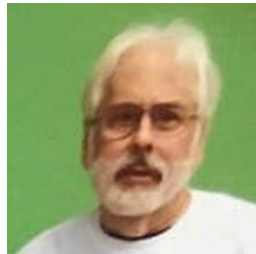


Charles has been teaching kids' camps for many years, and the most popular ones he offers at NAL in this upcoming summer 2023.
