## **“Show Us Your Stuff” at Schoenherr Gallery**

Here’s a wonderful opportunity in downtown Naperville!

Naperville Art League member artists are invited to enter their work in a juried show to be held at Schoenherr Gallery located in the Wentz Fine Arts Center on the campus of North Central College. The exhibit will take place **June 6 through July 29 with an artists’ reception on June 9, from 5 to 8 pm.**

The theme is “Show Us Your Stuff”. Up to 3 items per NAL member may be submitted for consideration and there is no size limitation or year of completion requirement. Art is open to 2D and 3D work.

To be considered in the jury process, **photos** of the items must be sent to [naperartleague@aol.com](mailto:naperartleague@aol.com) with **NCC exhibit** in the subject line, by **midnight May 13, 2023**. The following information must accompany the submission: artist name, the title of the piece, medium, size, price (if for sale), and insured value.

Art must be family-appropriate, and the presentation should adhere to exhibit rules.

### **Accepted art**

Acceptance letters will be sent via email on May 17 & 18 and will include exhibit rules.

A signed form with liability waiver for each accepted piece will be required prior to the drop-off date. The display fee of **\$25 per accepted item** will be due at drop-off, **May 30-31** (3-6pm both dates), (checks payable to Naperville Art League, or cash. No credit cards.). Drop-off will be at Schoenherr at the location/time indicated in the acceptance letter. (**We will not accept items at the NAL gallery.**)
