### Collage with an Iron

#### Supply List

- Apron
- Ruler
- Utility knife
- Pencil
- scissors
- Sketchbook- 6 x 6, 8 x 10, keep it small.
- Roll of paper towels
- Tub of baby wipes, generic is fine
- Roll of wax paper, (use to go between coated collage papers for storage.)
- 1 sheet of fine sandpaper, #220
- Small water bucket
- 2 glue sticks
- 1-days' worth of newspaper
- 1" flat brush
- Small round point paint brushed for details and shadow work
- 1-roll blue painters' tape, delicate grade, or any painters tape that is delicate, frog tape etc.
- 1-plastic dollar store table cover, or shower curtain, one for table and one for floor.
- Small box of wax crayons- Caran d Arche'
- A few cosmetic sponges wedges
- 3" or 2" Sponge paint roller- found at you craft store
- 10 paper plates – used for a palette
- Other magazine of interest for collage sketching.
- Cut 3 piece of 140lb. watercolor paper to 6" x 6" (hot or cold press it doesn't matter.)
- Cut 3-12 x 12, or 12 x 16, 140 lb. watercolor paper
- A selection of Coated Collage papers. (Or you will have to coat some after first for class).
- Nice selection acrylic paints, preferably in bottle can include craft paints.
- 1-16oz bottle of Golden's Gloss Medium, (it was called Polymer Medium (gloss) changed names recently)
- Stencils and stamping objects
