

WEB GALLERY SUBMISSIONS

You can now post your art on your own personal web gallery on the NAL web site. This is an excellent way to get some exposure and allow others to see your work. Below are the guidelines to help get you on your way.

Payment is \$25 for the current membership year.

This is based on the league's membership year of June 1st to May 31st.

Your biography and/or artist statement

- Submitted text can be up to 400 words. It should be spell checked, proofread and ready to insert into the gallery page.
- A .doc or .txt format is desired.
- All text should be in Upper and Lower Case. No All-Caps, please.

Number of images File format: jpeg at 72 dpi

- 10 images in digital format can be submitted in addition to a photo of the artist if desired.
- Images / content can be changed a maximum of 3 times during the year on a "as time permits " with no additional charge.
- Images should be in .jpg format at a maximum of 500 pixels horizontal and 750 pixels vertical at 72dpi. In other words, reduce the longest edge to fit into the 500 pixel width or 750 length and the shorter side will reduce proportionally.

Please name image files in lower case only.

- No spaces or gaps in the image name. Use an "underscore" (_) to separate words. i.e name_of_painting
- The webmaster has included a NAL Member Personal Website Links Section. This would contain a link to the individual artists personal site or blog and a sentence or two.
- All digital images should emailed to the webmaster at neil_moon2001@yahoo.com.

Imaging Help

- If people need help resizing digital images the webmaster can assist you with your images. The fee is \$3.00 an image or all 10 images (completed at the same time) would be \$25. This would be payable to the webmaster by check. Contact Neil Pradzinski, our webmaster, at neil_moon2001@yahoo.com
- If you only have slides or photos, please go to your local Kinkos-type establishment and have them scanned and saved to a CD as digital images at the sizes described above.

Remember that the webmaster cannot make a smaller image into a larger image without losing image quality.
